# Reading and Social Studies


In reading we will be using Fountas and Pinnell with Mrs. Halsey

In Social Studies we will be using Ohio Studies Weekly with Mrs. Breedlove!




### Math and Science



 Homework is generally an extension of what we are doing in class, but may also be skill review.




## Late Work Policy

# Make Up Work




 Things come up, illness happens. So, when you miss a day you get day.
